

Adult Care Facilities (ACFs) in Ohio

Licensing

ACFs are licensed and inspected by the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services.

Purpose

These facilities provide accommodations, personal care services, supervision and more to ensure the health and well-being of residents.

Need

Some individuals with serious mental illness are unable to live in the community without support. They become homeless, incarcerated, or hospitalized.

Benefits

ACFs help keep individuals with serious mental illness safe, maintain medication adherence, and develop life skills.

History

ACFs were created as a response to the high need for community housing and care for Ohioans with serious, debilitating mental illnesses.

Residents

Residents of ACFs live with chronic and debilitating mental illnesses such as schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, and major depression.
